

Declaration on REACH compliance

Dear Customer,

The REACH regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, which came into force on June 1st, 2007, governs the handling of chemicals and substances in preparations and products. In the meaning of this regulation, our company albis-elcon system Germany GmbH is a so-called downstream user.

According to this, the products you buy from us, are exempt from registration and also do not require the provision of safety data sheets.


However, article 33 of the REACH regulation stipulates that our suppliers are subject to a general information requirement regarding the use of substances of very high concern (SVHC) in a concentration exceeding 0.1 % weight by weight (w/w). These substances of very high concern (currently 201 as per July 16th, 2019) are listed on the "candidate list" that is published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and made available also on their website at <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest>.

We are in constant contact with our suppliers regarding the identification of potential critical substances and their substitution by harmless alternatives.
